Supervisory and Protective Husbanding Services	\$ 2000.00 for 5 days. Thereafter \$ 100.00 per day

All Types of Vessels

For arranging/servicing additional berths within a district	\$ 750.00 per berth. (Dry Bulk)
	\$ 750.00 per berth. (Tankers)

When a vessel is placed in temporary idle status, including By reason of strikes, but not including waiting for berth Or cargo	\$ 300.00 per day

17. Additional services in attending crew arrival/departure \$ 100.00 each man, including but not limited to arranging shore accommodations, victualing, transportation, repatriation, payment of bill etc.
18. Arranging medical treatment - \$ 30.00 per crewmember
19. AMS Services - \$ 560.00 for the first (5) B/L's and \$ 85.00 per each B/L thereafter
20. eNOA-D - \$ 350.00 each for Arrival and Departure
21. Fuel surcharge - \$ 200.00
22. Customs Bond - \$400.00
23. Handling USCG Restrictions - \$750.00 per occurrence
